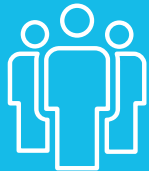

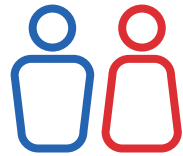

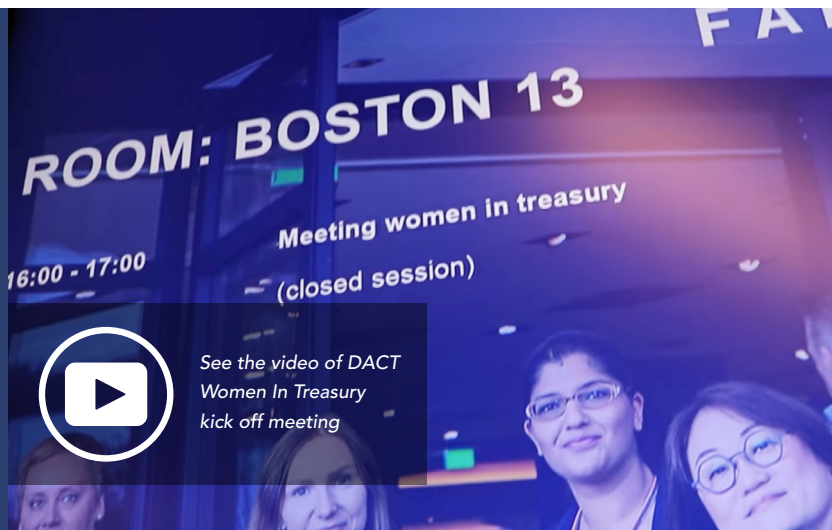
ADVISORY COUNCIL MEMBERS

In 2023, there was an increase in project submissions for the DACT Treasury Award, resulting in four nominations. The four nominees for the DACT Treasury Award 2023 were:

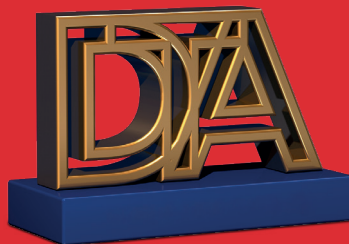

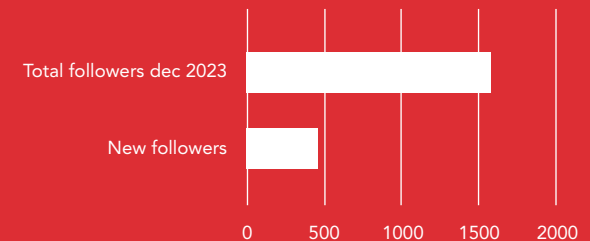
SOCIAL MEDIA

MENTORING PROGRAMME

'EXPERIENCED MEMBERS COACH YOUNGER PROFESSIONALS'

In 2020, research conducted by the DACT Mentoring Committee revealed that DACT members need support at the commencement of their treasury careers. Additionally, the research highlighted the strong motivation among experienced DACT members to assume mentorship roles. DACT maintains a mentor catalogue comprising nearly 35 treasury professionals with diverse functions, experiences, skills, and areas of expertise. In 2023, we updated the catalogue to ensure its relevance and effectiveness.

BAROMETER

The DACT Treasury Barometer is an annual independent survey among treasury professionals to identify the latest trends and developments.
